

EIGHTH-GRADE SUPPLY LIST

We are looking forward to working with you and your child this year. The following is a list of supplies needed for the upcoming school year. Please label all items with your child's name.

- 1 assignment planner/Agenda (for parents and teachers to check students' work)
- One ruler
- One triangle set
- One protractor
- One scholar compass
- 3 notebooks for math (**cannot be loose papers in binder; each notebook should be no less than 100 sheets; one for class notes, two for homework!**)
- 2 notebooks for science (**cannot be loose papers in binder, each notebook should be no less than 100 sheets**)
- One grid paper notebook for math
- One box standard staple (5,000 staples)
- 2 reusable dry erasable pockets
- 2-pack of 2 oz modeling compounds (color and brand do not matter)
- 4 boxes of tissues
- 2 packages of Expo Dry Erase Markers
- 30 file folders (1/3 cut, Manila)
- 4 containers of disinfectant wipes
- 1 pack of plastic forks and spoons
- 4 rolls of paper towel
- 2 bottles of hand sanitizers
 - 2 boxes of bandaids
 - 1 pkg of reusable ice packs (for first aid purpose)

If your child already has the things listed below, they can use them without needing to buy new things.
